Dear Prospective Student,

Thank you very much for your interest in Miranda Toastmasters' Speechcraft course. The next Speechcraft course will commence on Wednesday 6th October 2010. Speechcraft courses are conducted one night a week for eight consecutive weeks, with the eighth night being a graduation night. The Graduation will be held at the same venue with a meal and beverages supplied, and the cost of this for each participant is included in your payment for the course.

A Speechcraft course is designed to teach public speaking skills to members of the Toastmasters club, and non-members from the local community. During the program you will be invited to participate in Table Topics, which is an enjoyable way of learning impromptu speaking, present six prepared speeches and serve as an evaluator for your fellow Speechcrafters. You will also have the opportunity to practice secondary assignments such as proposing a Toast and introducing a speaker to an audience.

On the first night you will receive your own folder which amongst other materials includes the "Speechcrafters Handbook". This handbook contains six speaking projects which are the foundation stones for anything you wish to do in the future that involves public speaking.

During each session there will be educational presentation and a demonstration speech from the project that you will be working through for the next session. This is designed to help you prepare your assignment for the following week.

The cost of the Speechcraft course is \$295.00 per person.

Should you wish to join Miranda Toastmasters Club following your graduation, your payment for Speechcraft course also covers the joining and membership fee until the next membership renewal period. You will receive a credit for the first three speaking projects in the "Competent Communication" program which will set you on your way to achieving the first Toastmasters award, the Competent Communicator award.

Once you have achieved this award, you can then start working through the "Advanced Communication" program, which is all very rewarding.

To enroll in this course, simply return the completed Speechcraft Registration form along with your payment. Enrollment is only achieved with full payment.
