Dear Prospective Student,

Thank you very much for your interest in Miranda Toastmasters Speechcraft course. The next Speechcraft course will commence on **Wednesday 12th February 2020**. Speechcraft courses are conducted on Wednesday nights for eight consecutive weeks. Sessions 1-7, are for study and practice. Session 8 is the graduation which is a special night of recognition. The Speechcraft students are encouraged to invite family, friends and colleagues to the graduation, to help celebrate the student's achievements in an after dinner speaking environment.

A Speechcraft Orientation night is held the Wednesday before the course commences to help the students prepare for the first session. This is held in the same venue as the Speechcraft course. Speechcraft is designed to teach public speaking skills. During the program you will be invited to participate in Table Topics, which is an enjoyable way of learning impromptu speaking, present eight prepared speeches and serve as an evaluator for your fellow Speechcrafters. You will also have the opportunity to learn and practice other speaking roles such as proposing a Toast and introducing a speaker to an audience.

On the first night you will receive your Speechcraft folder which includes, the "Speechcrafters Workbook" with six speaking projects, an additional Toastmasters' speaking project, and other educational materials.

During each session there will be an educational presentation and a demonstration speech from the project that you will be working with for the following session. This will help you to prepare your assignment for the next week.

The cost of the Speechcraft course is **\$450.00** per person.

Should you wish to join Miranda Toastmasters Club following your graduation, your payment for Speechcraft course also covers the joining and membership fee until the next membership renewal period. You will receive a credit for the first three speaking projects in the "Competent Communication" program which will set you on your way to achieving the first Toastmasters award, the Competent Communicator award.

Once you have achieved this award, you can then start working through the "Advanced Communication" program, which takes you to a higher skill level.

To enrol in this course, simply return the completed Speechcraft Registration form (page 3) along with your payment. Enrolment is only achieved with full payment.
